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What else do I need to know?

Curriculum Specialist Youth Workers

There are currently 1.5 FTE Active Involvement Specialist Youth Workers working for the service to promote active involvement for young people. Their priority, like yours, is ensuring that Active Involvement Team develop effectively in every community based youth project we run.

They also have lead responsibility within the Youth Service for the following programmes:

City Active Involvement Team

Once you have established an active involvement team in your community based project you will be required to support that team in nominating a member to sit on the City Active Involvement Team. Although the Active Involvement Specialist workers will run the monthly meetings of this team and coordinate the information to and from these meetings, you will have a very important support role to play. You will need to:

- **Encourage** the project AI Team to nominate someone to represent their community based project at an early meeting in September 2005
- **Integrate** discussion about City Active Involvement Team booklet into planned programmes.
- **Support** the nominated individual in attending and discussing the monthly meetings and his/her contribution to, and feedback from them.
- **Facilitate** the project AI Team in making the most of the representation they have on the City AI Team.
- **Communicate** regularly with the Active Involvement Specialist Workers about taking this partnership forward.
